This Indenture Made 15th day of January in the year
of our Lord One Thousand and Eight Hundred and Ninety
Eight between W. W. O'Connor and his wife Mary E. O'Connor
both of Toledo Lewis County State of Washington parties
of the first part, Gust Anderson of Lewis County State
of Washington party of the second part. It witnesseth, That the
said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the
sum of One Dollar and other valuable lawful money of the
United States of America to us in hand paid, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,
sold, promised, released Conveyed and quit-claimed and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell premise release
Convey and quit-Claim unto the said party of the second
part and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the right,
title and interest, estate, claim and demands of said
parties of the first part, of, in and to that certain portion
claim and mining right, title and property on a certain
ledge, vein, lode or deposites of quartz and other rocks
in place, containing precious metals of gold, silver and
other metals and situated in the St. Helens Mining District
County of Skamania and state of Washington described
as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the end line of the South East
Discovery Claim of the Norway Lode about twenty (20)
feet North West of the Discovery on Lake Canyon Creek
about one half $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile above the mouth of said
creek and about twenty five (75) feet above the Spirit
Lake Trail where it crosses the creek. The claim runs
Fifteen hundred (1500) feet in a South Easterly direction
and three hundred (300) feet on each side of center of said
claim or lode.

Together with all dikes spurs and angles
and also all the metals, ores gold, silver and metal
bearing Quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the
rights privileges and franchises there to incident appur-
tenant and appurtenant or there with usually had or enjoyed
and also all the estate right title interest, possession
claim and demand whatsoever, of the said parties of
the first part of, in or to the premises and every part and
parcel thereof —
