Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all my estate, right, title and Interest in and to the same including dower and claim of dower: To Have and To Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said George C. Jones, Sen, his heirs and assigns forever. And I said George C. Jones Jr, grantor above named do covenant to and with said George C. Jones, Sen, the above named grantee his heirs and assigns, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
