

11 Satisfaction of Mortgage Jacob H. Cook to Charles Heilmann

Know all men by these Presents, That I Jacob H. Cook, unmarried, of Carbonburg, Forest County Pennsylvania do hereby certify and declare that a certain Mortgage bearing date the 29th day of September 1896 made and executed by Charles Heilmann the party of the first part therein to Jacob H. Cook the party of the second part, therein and recorded in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Schuylkill Washington in Book of Mortgages on Page 121, on the second day of October 1896 and given to secure the payment of a certain promissory note for one hundred dollars, dated September 29, 1896, with interest at the rate of 12 per cent, per annum, made by the said Charles Heilmann in favor of the said Jacob H.
