

From A. Hooper to Frank E. Ostborn

This Indenture Made the Twenty sixth day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ninety eight between A. Hooper (sumamed) of Toledo State of Washington Lewis County party of the first part and Frank E. Ostborn party of the second part Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and Consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States of America to him in hand paid by the said party of the second, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, promised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, promise release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, the undivided one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Quartz Claim lode as located surveyed and recorded and held by the said party of the first part situated in St. Helens Mining District in Skamania County State of Washington and known and described as follows: "The Mary" viz:

Beginning at the Center of what is known as Florence Creek a tributary of the North Fork of the River and running 1500 feet in a South Westerly direction and 300 feet on each side of Center of said lode including all dips spurs and angles.

The Discovery is about 600 feet of above the "Mountain Fairy" discovery and about 2000 feet Northwest of Lake Meta and about one mile Northwest of Mount Bierbeck.

And that party of the second part shall hold an undivided one half interest in the above described property. Together with all the dips spurs and angles and also all the metals ore gold and silver bearing quartz rock and earth therein; and all the rights privileges and franchises thereto incident appurtenant and appurtenant or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also all and singular
