Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and also all its estate, right, title and interest, at law and equity, therein or thereto.

To have and to hold, the same to the said E. L. Green and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said The Stevenson Land Company does covenant with the said E. L. Green and his legal representatives forever, that the said real estate is free from all incumbrances, and that it will and its successors shall, warrant and defend the same to the said E. L. Green and to his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever.
