

From A. Hooper to Geo H. Lucke & F. M. McLeod

This Indenture made the Tenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ninety-Eight between A. Hooper (unmarried) of Toledo State of Washington, Lewis County party of the first part, and Geo H. Lucke and F. M. McLeod parties of the second part, witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar lawful money of the United States of America to me in hand paid by the said parties of the second, this receipt whereby is hereby acknowledged has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quit claimed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns their undivided right of the Quartz claim lode as located, surveyed, recorded and held by said party of the first part situated in St. Helens Mining District in Skamania County State of Washington and known and described as follows:

Named "The Mary" lode.

Beginning at the center of what is known as Florence Creek a tributary of the North Fork and running 1500 feet in a South Easterly direction and 300 feet on each side of center of said Lode including all dips, spurs and angles.

The discovery is about 600 feet above the Mountain Fairy discovery and about 2000 feet North West of Lake Meta and about one mile South West of Mt. Benchmark. And that parties of the second part shall each hold an undivided $\frac{1}{8}$ interest in the above described property. Together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver-bearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the rights privilege and franchises thereto incident, appurtenant and appurtenant or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also all and
