

100-yards Below the Triple Falls also at a fall on Blue Bird Creek, thence commencing at code and running 300 fr. in a North Easterly direction to corner stake: thence 1000 fr. in a South Easterly direction to corner stake: thence 300 fr. in a South Westerly direction to center stake: thence 300 fr. in the same direction to corner stake: thence 1500 fr. in a North Westerly direction to corner stake: thence 300 fr. in a North Easterly direction to place of beginning.

3rd An undivided one quarter interest in the Quartz Ledge or code known as the Gray Eagle and described as follows, to wit: On the South side of Blue Bird Creek about one half mile from main Washington River and about 300 yards up said Creek above mouth of creek intersecting said Blue Bird Creek on North Side 2nd about $\frac{1}{3}$ mile below first falls on said Blue Bird Creek, said claim to be 1500 ft. from this notice in a South Easterly direction and 300 ft.
