

in the Bald Mountain Mining District (unorganized) County of Stansania State of Washington and extending 1500 feet to and from discovery or location; notice at discovery shaft exterior boundary of this Claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows: - 100 yards below the Triple fall also at a Fall on Blue Bird Creek; thence commencing at lode and running 300 ft in north easterly direction to corner stake; thence 1500 feet in a south easterly direction to corner stake; thence 300 feet in a south westerly direction to corner stake, thence 300 feet in the same direction to corner stake, thence 1500 in north westerly direction to corner stake, thence 300 feet in a north easterly direction to place of beginning.

3rd An undivided one fourth interest in the Quartz ledge or lode known as the Gray Eagle and described as follows - to-wit: - on the south side of the Blue Bird Creek about one half mile from Main Washangal River and about 300 yards up said Creek above mouth of Creek intersecting said Creek north side and about one third mile below First Falls on said Blue Bird Creek said Claim to be 1500 feet from this notice in a southeasterly direction and 300 feet each end west from Center of ledge.

4th An undivided one fourth interest in the Blue Bird Quartz Mining Claim situated and described as follows; about 150 yards from the head of Blue Bird Creek a tributary of Main Washangal River and East of Bald Mountain about one mile and on the head of said Blue Bird Creek east and the foot of Huckleberry Butte next to Triple Falls of said Creek 1500 feet along lead in a southeasterly direction
