Iman, his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant and agree to pay unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators or assigns, the said sum of money, as above mentioned.

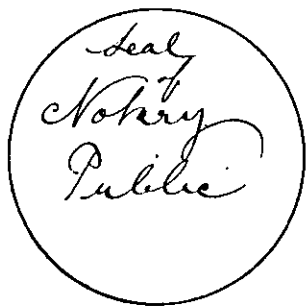
