

NOTICE OF APPRIPIATION OF WATER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the undersigned, do hereby claim the water lying, being and flowing in that certain stream known as Kanaka Creek, at the point at which this notice is posted to the extent of one cubic foot per second of time, such point of diversion being in the south-east part of the north-west quarter of the northeast quarter of Sec. 36 Tp 3 North Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian.

The purpose for which said water is to be appropriated is to construct and intake and therefrom conduct said water by means of pipes or flumes to a point at or near the town of Stevenson, Skamania county, Washington, to be distributed by proper system for domestic and fire protection purposes.

The means by which it is intended to store or divert said water is by means of pipes or flumes as aforesaid, and store the same in proper reservoirs as distributing points for that purpose.
