

JAMES SHEPARD TO THE PUBLIC.

AFFIDAVIT.

I, James Shepard, being first duly sworn, on oath say that I am a resident and inhabitant of the County of Skamania, State of Washington; that I have been such resident for the past 30 years; that I am a son of Lucinda N. Shepard; that Lucinda N. Shepard died intestate September 27th, 1899, leaving as her children and heirs at law, six (6) children, to-wit:- Richard, James, William, Nancy, Heathy Ellen and Elizabeth; that Nancy Shepard married one, Marion Vanderpool; that Heathy Ellen Shepard married one, Edward B. Fuller; that Elizabeth Shepard married one, Henry Holtgrieve;

That on the 23rd day of October, 1900, R.N. Shepard was a single man; that said R.N. Shepard mentioned in deed to Peter Olson, dated October 23rd, 1900, recorded in Book "G" at page 154 thereof, is one and the same person as Richard N. Shepard mentioned in deed dated June 7th, 1893, recorded in Book "E", page 64; that William F. Shepard mentioned in deed recorded in Book "D" page 282, as grantee, and Wm. T. Shepard mentioned in that certain deed recorded in Book "I" page 526, and William Shepard mentioned in deed recorded in Book "E" page 73 thereof, all of the records of deeds of Skamania County, Washington, are one and the same person;

That I am personally acquainted with the descriptions of the several parcels of land within the South half of the Shepard D. L. C. and know of my own knowledge that all of Riverview Addition to the town of Stevenson, according to the official plat whereof, is within the south half of said D. L. C. That I make this affidavit freely and voluntarily and from my own personal knowledge.
