Know all men by these Presents, That I Lillie Graaff (formerly Lillie Gumborn) of Menominee Landing, Stannania County State of Washington and her-at-law of Felix Gumborn, deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to one in hand paid by Julius S. Graaff of Menominee Landing, Stannania County, State of Washington the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for the further consideration of the love and affection I bear unto the said Julius S. Graaff, my legal and lawful husband, have bargained sold assigned and conveyed and by these presents do sell, assign and convey unto the said Julius S. Graaff, all my right, title and interest in and to a full one undivided one half of that certain piece or parcel of real estate more particularly described as follows:

The ^{west} South quarter of the South ~~west~~ quarter of section twenty-six (26) the East half of the South east quarter and North west quarter of South east quarter of section twenty-seven (27) in Township Two (2), North of Range six (6) East of Willamette Meridian in said Stannania County State of Washington. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto, also all my right, title and interest in and to the same. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said Julius S. Graaff his heirs and assigns forever.
