

perly applicable to the satisfaction of the sum due upon said note hereby secured, including interest, attorneys fee and costs, there should remain any part thereof unsatisfied, that deficiency judgment for such amount remaining unsatisfied may be entered against the said parties of the first part.

Ninth. And it is hereby further agreed that said parties of the first part expressly waive all right and benefit which they may be entitled to under the laws of the state of Washington by reason of homestead right in and to said mortgaged premises or any part thereof.

The foregoing covenant being performed this conveyance shall be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.
