NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, that the Forest Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture, has appropriated and hereby appropriates water now flowing or that may hereafter flow, to the extent of four (4) second feet, in the Little White Salmon River, Skamania County, State of Washington, to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes.

The water to be diverted from the point or place at which this notice is posted, which is in Section 36, Township 5 North, Range 9, East, W.M., by the erection of a dam, and to be conveyed therefrom by a flume or ditch in a southerly direction, and to be used at the Oklahoma Ranger Station, which is located in Section 36, Township 5 North, Range 9 East, and in Section 1, Township 4 North, Range 9 East, W.M.
