NOTICE OF WATER APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That we, J. D. Tilton and John M. Haley, the appropriators whose names are hereto subscribed have appropriated and do hereby appropriate and claim the water lying, being and flowing in this stream, commonly known as the North Fork of Buck Creek, to the extent of 4 cu. ft. per second of time, said water to be used for irrigating, domestic, and other purposes.

That a copy of this notice is posted on the south side of a fir tree standing on the north bank of said north fork of Buck Creek at or near the intended point of diversion, which said point is about 3 and one-fourth miles from where the said Buck Creek empties into the White Salmon River and in section ten, township four, North Range Ten East of the Willamette Meridian.

That it is our intention to divert the water from said stream by means of an open ditch, pipes, or flume, and to use storage reservoirs, if necessary and convey the water by said means in a southerly and Easterly direction to the lands owned by the appropriators herein named, being situated and described as The north-east quarter of the northwest quarter; the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter; the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter; and the north half of the northeast quarter of section 26 and the south half of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 23, all in Township four, north range 10 E.W.M.

That we claim the water herein appropriated, all and singular under any and all laws, National and State, rulings and decisions thereunder in the matter of water rights.

Together with all and singulars the heretofore and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining or to accrue to the same.
