

A. H. Kenyon to Spokane & Vancouver Gold & Copper Co.

Mining Deed

This Indenture, made this 26th day of January A. D. 1898. between A. H. Kenyon of the County of Spokane and State of Washington party of the first part, and the Spokane and Vancouver Gold and Copper Company, a domestic corporation of the County of Spokane and State of Washington party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred Dollars Gold Coin of the United States, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath Granted, Bargained, Sold, Remised, Released, and forever Quit Claimed, and, by these presents, does Grant, Bargain, Sell, Remise, Release, and forever Quit Claim, unto the said party of the second part its successors and assigns, the Ida Martin Quartz Mining Claim as located, surveyed, recorded and held by said party of the first part, situated in Copper Creek Mining District Skamania County, State of Washington, located by William Satterfeed, August 17th 1896, relocated May 17th 1897, a copy of the amended Notice of Location duly recorded in the office of the County Auditor, of Stevens County, Washington May 21 1897. Book C Miscellaneous page 316, reference being hereby made to said copy of notice as a part of the description, said claim lying on the southerly slope of Copper Creek, one and one half miles from mouth of Canyon Creek. Adjoins the Big Elephant and Yellow Bird mining claims on the South together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz, rock and earth therein, and all the rights, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had or enjoyed; and also all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said part of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.
