Said appropriator claims under this location two hundred (200) cubic feet of water per second of time flowing past this point of posting this notice of location about one fourth of a mile above the mouth of Gum Boot Creek on the South or East

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Location Notice of Water Right and site for Power and Mining Purposes.

Skamania County

State of Washington

We the undersigned citizens of the United States do hereby appropriate two hundred cubic feet of water per second of time under the laws, and all the water flowing past this point on South or East fork of Lewis River for the purpose of power, mining or generating of electrical power, or any other useful purpose by damming the same over what is known as Sun Set Falls on said stream. We claim the land (20) twenty rods in width on each side the stream at the meander of the center line for a distance of (65) sixty five rods northeasterly and (15) fifteen rods southwesterly from this point on this the 22nd day of July, 1909 by the undersigned locators.
