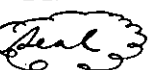
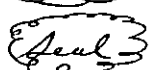
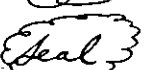
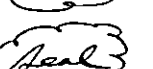


in and to said mine. that the interest of the party of the first part shall be protected as herein stipulated.

It is herein further agreed that the said party of the first part is to have and enjoy the privilege of examining all records, books, expense accounts in connection with said mine and to have free access to said mine for the purpose of examining same at all reasonable times.

And it is further herein agreed that the party of the second part shall as soon as practicable make such tests, excavations, development and examination of and in connection with said mine as shall satisfy said party of the first part that said mine can be operated at a profit, and finding that such tests as may be applied are unsatisfactory it is agreed that this bond shall thereupon be at once relinquished, and it is further agreed that upon its relinquishment or failure to comply with conditions herein set forth that all moneys paid hereunder and all improvements made thereon shall be forfeited to the said party of the first part as a penalty and for liquidated damages, and notice of forfeiture is hereby expressly waived, and also all right, demand or claim for the balance of any of said sum of One Thousand Dollars. And it is hereby agreed by the parties of the second part that they will and their assigns shall pay all claims contracted by the said second party in improving or operating said mine and maintain said mine free from all liens on account of work performed by said second party.

Now, if the party of the second part shall fail to pay the sum of money as hereinbefore provided or to perform the covenants herein contained, and if the party of the first part shall faithfully perform the covenants herein set forth, then this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.
