ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

THE STEVENSON WATER COMPANY, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, We, the undersigned, P.S.C. Wills, E.P. Ash, and Geo. E. O'Bryon, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and to that end and purpose, make, subscribe and acknowledge these written articles of incorporation in triplicate to-wit:

1.

The name of this corporation shall be THE STEVENSON WATER COMPANY.

2.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are to acquire <sup>hotter mineral and</sup> construct, own, enlarge, maintain and operate waterworks/other springs, and to supply municipalities, corporations and individuals with water and water power, and to acquire, erect, maintain, construct and enlarge all necessary dams buildings, plant, machinery fixtures and apparatus of every sort for supplying municipalities, corporations and individuals with water and water power for all purposes and to carry on the business incidental thereto, including the purpose of acquiring, constructing, enlarging, maintaining and operating water-works, pumping stations and a system of water supply and the dams, reservoirs, pumping stations and conduits thereto appertaining in the City of Stevenson and Skamania County and elsewhere in the State of Washington, and supplying the city of Stevenson in said State of Washington and the territory adjacent thereto and the citizens and inhabitants thereof and the corporations located and transacting business therein with water and water power for domestic, mechanical, public, and fire and all other purposes with power to acquire, hold, lease and convey real and person estate suitable for the business of the corporation, and to acquire, own, hold, possess and convey franchises and grants from state or municipal authorities for supplying cities, villages and towns or either, and the inhabitants thereof with water for all purposes and the carrying on the business of operating water-works, and to acquire and to own stock and bonds of other corporations organized for like purposes, and to acquire, own, hold and possess all such other personal property as may be suitable or convenient for the business of the Company and with the right to issue bonds and secure the same by mortgage of the franchises, rights, contracts and property of the corporation real and personal, and to issue common capital stock and to do all and everything necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainments of any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated, which shall at any time appear for the benefit of the corporation and in general to carry on any other business, whether manufacturing or other, which may seem to the corporation capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with the above or calculated to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the corporation's property or rights

3-The Capital stock of this corporation shall be One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars, which shall be divided into one hundred (100) shares of the par value of \$10.00 each 4-The time of the existence of this corporation shall be fifty years 5-The Trustees of this corporation shall be Three in number and the names and places of residence of the Trustees who shall manage the concerns of the corporation until the 15th day of June 1916, are P.S.C.Wills, E.P.Ash and Geo.E. O'Bryon. 6- The principal place of business of this corporation shall be at Stevenson, Washington.
