D.G. JACKSON CO. TO THE PUBLIC.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
D.G. JACKSON CO.

These presents, witness, That we, D.G. Jackson, Ella P. Jackson and D.P. Gillam, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purposes hereinafter mentioned and specified, and in conformity to the laws of the State of Washington, do make and subscribe the following written Articles of Incorporation in triplicate, to-wit:

ARTICLE 1.

The name of this corporation shall be D.G. JACKSON CO.

ARTICLE 11.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed is and shall be:

1. To carry on a general mercantile and commission business in the town of Underwood Skamania County, Washington, and generally in said State of Washington, and surrounding territory, and so carry on retail business in goods, wares and merchandise of all kinds and nature whatsoever, useful and ornamental, dry-goods, groceries, hardware, machinery and implements etc.

2. To conduct and carry on a general ware-house and storage business, including refrigeration or cold storage, as same may be found expedient and beneficial to this corporation.
3. Also to conduct and carry on a dray and livery business.
4. To hold, own, purchase or otherwise acquire, and to improve, lease, sell, convey, mortgage or otherwise hypothecate real and personal property.
5. To purchase, acquire own, hold and sell stocks of other corporations, and also bonds, mortgages, pledges, notes or other choses in action, judgments, liens, and other equities.

ARTICLE III.

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be \$25,000.00 and divided into 250 shares of the par value of \$100. each.

ARTICLE IV.

The time of the existence of this corporation shall be fifty years.

ARTICLE V.

The number of the Trustees (or Board of Directors) of this corporation shall be three, and the names and residences of the trustees who shall manage the concerns of the corporation until the first day of July, 1915, are:

D.G. Jackson, Hood River, Ore.
D.P. Gillam, Underwood, Washington.
Ella P. Jackson, Hood River, Ore.

ARTICLE VI.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be at Underwood, Skamania County, Washington.
