ouchers, acquittances, deeds, or other papers necessary, incident and proper to fully discharge and release all property formerly possessed by Daniel Jones, deceased, from any claim or demand on my behalf and to do any and all things in my behalf necessary incident and proper in the settlement of the estate in the same manner as I might do if personally present, hereby confirming ratifying and allowing whatever thing or things my said attorney or attorneys may lawfully do in the premises.
