

John Mackay wife to Mike Supple.

Witnesseth, That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred fifteen Dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has bargained, sold, aliened, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents does bargain, sell alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that piece or parcel of land situated in Okanogan County State of Washington and better described as the N. E. (1/4) North East quarter of the S. E. 1/4 North East quarter, and the S. E. 1/4 South East quarter of the N. E. 1/4 North East quarter, and the S. W. South West fraction of the N. W. 1/4 North West quarter said to contain (97) ninety seven acres.

Together with ~~all the~~^{the} tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and ~~all~~^{of} all the estate, right, title, interest, dower and right of dower, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever of said party of the first part, of, in and to the ~~same~~, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits there of. To Have and hold To Hold, the hereinbefore granted, bargained and described premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, to his and their own use, benefit and behoof forever. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four hundred fifteen Dollars, and ---- cents, in accordance with the terms of a certain promissory note, of which the following is a true copy, to wit:
