

John Frank to Wm. M. Strunk.

The Mortgagor John Frank of Washougal Clarke County Washington mortgages to William M. Strunk of Fishers Landing Washington the property hereinafter described, to secure the payment of One hundred Dollars, according to the terms of a certain promissory note, of which the following is substantially a copy, to-wit:

On or before Three Years after date, without grace, for value received, I promise to pay to William M. Strunk of Fishers Landing, Wash or order, at Fishers Landing Wash One hundred Dollars, with interest from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum interest payable annually, and if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible, at the option of the holder of this note. If not so collected, the interest to be added to and become part of the principal, and the same to bear interest thereafter, until paid at the rate of 8 per cent per Annum Principal and interest payable in U. S. Gold Coin. And in case action is commenced to enforce payment of this note, or any portion thereof, I promise to pay such additional sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees in said action.
