Ash, of the County of Wasco in the State of Oregon, have this day bargained and sold, and do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said R. Black, One third ($\frac{1}{3}$) and the said C. P. Ash two thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) undivided interest in and to the following described lands and premises lying, being and situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, to-wit Lots 26 and 27 in Block One (1) in the Town of Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington as shown by the official plat of said town now of file and of record in the office of the Auditor of said County and State together with all and singular the rights, privileges, improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any way incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold unto the said R. Black and C. P. Ash their heirs and assigns forever; and the title to the foregoing described premises, and every part thereof we bind ourselves and our heirs and legal representatives to forever warrant and defend unto the said R. Black and C. P. Ash and to their heirs, assigns and legal representatives against the lawful claims of all persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
