

Amos Underwood and Ellen to Horriet E. Miller

This Indenture, made and entered into this 7th day of February AD 1896. Between Amos Underwood and Ellen Underwood husband and wife of Skamania County, State of Washington parties of the first part; and Horriet E. Miller of the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon party of the second part. Witnesseth. That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.) Dollars in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever, all the following described real estate, lying and being situate in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, to-wit:

Lot One (1) and the South West-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the North West-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty three (23) in Township Three (3) North of Range Ten (10) East of Willamette Meridian also the following described tract of land situated in the County of Klickitat and State of Washington, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot Two (2) and the South East-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the North West-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty three (23) in Township Three (3) North of Range Ten (10) East of Willamette Meridian.

Containing in half tracts 155 $\frac{50}{100}$ acres One hundred and fifty five and fifty hundredths of an acre.

Together with all and singular the privileges, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

To Have and To Hold the same, To the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever.
