

J. S. Graaff & wife to Carl Lindstrom

The Mortgagors J. S. Graaff, and Lillian Graaff, his wife mortgage to Carl Lindstrom the property hereinafter described, to secure the payment of One Thousand Dollars, according to the terms of a certain promissory note of which the following is substantially a copy, to wit:

On or before November 9th 1901, for value received we promise to pay to Carl Lindstrom or order, the sum of One Thousand Dollars with interest at the rate of Eight per cent per annum. If the interest is not paid when due it shall be compounded with the principal and bear like interest. Principal and interest payable in United States gold coin, and in case suit is instituted to collect this note, or any portion thereof we promise to pay such additional sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees, to be taxed as part of such suit, for the use of Plaintiff's attorney.
