For supplying power for the operation of railroads and other means of transportation, and for all and every public use and service to which water, or water power, or electricity generated from water power can in any way be used.

Notice is hereby further given that the undersigned pursuant to this appropriation intends to divert 2000 cubic feet of water per second of time from said stream, at and near the point where this Notice is posted; and to cause said quantity of water to flow therefrom in a westerly direction along the right shore about fifteen miles to the power house site.

The means by which it is intended to divert said water are dams flumes ditches pipes and conduits.
