Treiber, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations to me in hand paid by Frank Larsen, of Underwood, Washington, do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said Frank Larsen, all my right, title and interest in and to that certain license to keep and operate a ferry across the Columbia River from the town of Underwood in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to the opposite shore within the County of Hood River in the State of Oregon at or near the City of Hood River therein for a period of five years from December 1st, 1913, which license was granted to me by the County Commissioners of said County of Skamania on December 1st, 1913, the said license and all the rights and privileges granted to me thereby.
