Hooper his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington.

An undivided one-third ($\frac{1}{3}$) interest in the following described mining claims,

"Victoria No. 7" "Victoria No. 1"

"Victoria No. 9" "Victoria No. 3"

"Victoria No. 5"

and

"Eureka No. 1 and No. 2"

All situate in St. Helens Mining district and duly recorded in the office of the County Recorder of said County and State

together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining; and also, all my estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

To Have and to Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said A. Hooper his heirs and assigns forever. And Barney O'Neill grantor above named does covenant with A. Hooper the above named grantee his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
