

NOTICE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, R.D. Cammeron and Margaret X. Cammeron, husband and wife, claim the water from this stream, known as Big Spring, all water running or flowing in said stream to the extent of thirty-^{inches miners measure} six cubic inches of water per second per acre. The purposes for which said water is appropriated is for house hold, domestic and irrigation purposes and the place of intended use is the farms or premises of the above mentioned appropriators lying and being in Section Ten (10) and Eleven (11) in Township Three (3) North of Range Ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian.

The means by which it is intended to divert the water from said stream is a head gate and conveyed by means of flume and pipes and ditches.

It is intended to divert said water from said stream at or near the point where a copy of this notice is posted, and more particularly and definitely described as follows: at a near the head-gate located at the point on said stream about midway between the North and South line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter Section 10, N.R. 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, State of Washington, from which corner of Section 10 in T. 3 N.R. 10, E. 10, bears in a Northeasterly direction about 100 rods distant.
