

STATE OF WASHINGTON-----CHAS.A.FRAZER.

I, the undersigned, do hereby give notice that I claim the water being and flowing in Little Buck Creek to the extent of six (6) cubic feet of water per second of time for the purpose of fluming, manufacturing and irrigation.

Said Water will be used to flume lumber and timber products from the vicinity of the sawmill now located near the center of Section nine (9), in Township three (3) of range ten (10) east of the Willamette Meridian, or from such other mill as may be located or constructed in or near sections five (5) and nine (9) in said township and range to the Columbia River or to the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company's Railway.

Said water is to be used for manufacturing purposes in connection with such sawmills.

The said water is to be used for irrigating the lands in Sections four (4) five (5) and nine (9) in said township and Range, and the lands lying to the South and east of said sections and between Little Buck Creek and the White Salmon River on the East and Little Buck Creek and the Columbia River on the South.

The said water is to be stored in a reservoir or lake created by a dam to be constructed at the point of diversion hereinafter described. The means of diverting said water shall be by flume, pipe or ditch. The point of diversion and of the purposed dam shall be at or near the forks of Little Buck Creek in the northeast quarter of section five (5) in Township three (3) north of range ten (10) east of the Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, Washington, the said point being marked by a hemlock tree twelve (12) inches in diameter situated on the South bank of Little Buck Creek at a point North 2° 45' west 39 feet from a galvanized iron pipe one inch in diameter and four feet in length with an elbow at the top, said galvanized iron pipe having been driven into the ground at a point 2216.3 feet west (by magnetic bearing) from the quarter corner on the east side of said section five (5) in township three (3) north of range ten (10) east of the Willamette Meridian.
