

Herman A. Hill et ux. to Jonathan Bourne Jr.

This Indenture, Made this 7th day of August in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine Between Herman A. Hill and Jessie Hill, his wife parties of the first part, and Jonathan Bourne, Jr. party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of divers good and valuable considerations and the sum of One Dollar lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described mining claim situated in Township Three (3) North of Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian in the Bald Mountain mining district in the County of Okanogan, State of Washington, to wit:

The claim known and recorded as the "Daisy" claim, on the Last Chanceode, said claim having been located June 12, 1895 by the said Herman Hill and recorded November 29th 1895 in Book "B" at page 43, Miscellaneous Records of said Okanogan County.

Together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals ore, gold and silver-bearing quartz rock and earth therein; and all the rights, privileges, and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also, all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profit thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said parties of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.

To have and to hold, all and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
