

decree, that the marriage contract heretofore existing between the plaintiff, Doratha Henjum, and the defendant, Iver Henjum, be dissolved, and that the same is hereby dissolved accordingly, and that the said parties are and each of them is freed and absolutely released from the bonds of matrimony and all the obligations thereof.

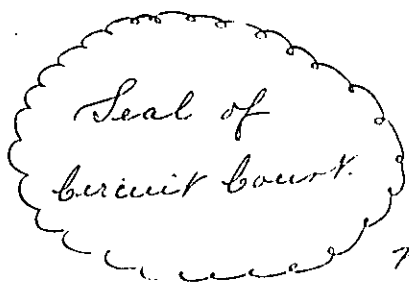
Ordered further, that plaintiff retain the care and custody of said minor children, issue of said marriage, let judgment be entered accordingly.

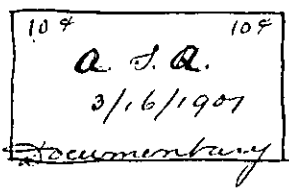
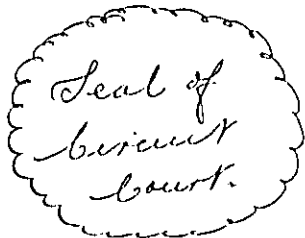
