ARTICLES OF INCOMPORATION OF THE

H-S LUMBER COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we the undersigned, E.B. Howe of Portland Oregon, and Ben Sweet, now of Portland, Oregon, but about to become a resident of Cooks, Washington, both citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated. For the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and for that purpose we here by make and subscribe the following articles of incopporation in triplicate.

ARTICLE 1.

The name assumed by this comporation and by which it shall be known is H-S Lumber Co."

ARTICLE 11.

The objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1. To carry on a general lumber, logging, timber, wood and shingle business, and for the successful consumation of hese enterprises to manufacture, buy and sell at wholesale and retail, logs, lumber, shingles and building material of every kind and desdription.
- 2.To purchase, own and sell fimber lands, stumpage, logging roads, logging rights and priveleges, and to act as agent for others in buying, handling and shipping logs, timber patuaps, wood and shipping.
- 3.To contract, purchase, or otherwise acquire, own and operate railroads, tram roads, logging roads, flumes, logging booms, docks and piers; and to erect, acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise buildings, sawmills, dry kilns, planning mills, shingle mills, blacksmith shops, etc., which may be necessary or convenient in connection with the carrying on of it's business.
 - 4.To buy, sell or own all kinds of real and personal property.
 - 5.To buy and sell merchandise.
- 6.To operate boarding houses or carry on any other line of business which may be necessary or expedient for furthering the interests of said corporation.
- 7.To purchase stock in other corporations as well as to purchase and retire or other-wine dispose of it's own capital stock.
- 8.To do all things except as limited by law, whether as principal or agent, in the transaction of it's said business to the same extent as a natural person could or might do, the rights, powers and privileges herein expressed being in furtherance and not in limitation of the laws of the State of Washington.

ARTICLE 111. The amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) and the same shall be divided into One Thousand Shares Hunared (1000) of the par value of One/KNANKANK Mollars (\$100.00) per share/

ARTICLE 1V.

The duration of the existence of this copporation shall be fifty (50) years or until the same shall be disolved as provided by law.

ARTICLE V.

The concerns of this company shall be managed, up to and including the first day of Scytember, 1918, by two (2) trustees whose names and addresses and residences shall be as follows: E.S. Howe of Portland Oregon and Ben Sweet of Cooks, Washington.

ARTICLE VI.

The saffice and principal clace of business of this corporation shall be at Cooks, Skamania County, State of Washington.
