## Notice of Water Right

State of Washington

County of Skamania, ss. To all concerned: Notice is hereby given that Milton L. Baldy of Spokane, Wn. hereby claim the use of the waters of White Salmon River to the extent of 1000 cubic feet per second. 2nd. It is intended to divert said water at or near the point where a copy of this notice is posted and more definitely described as follows: About 600 feet NE of the NW corner Sec. 31 T 4 N. R. 11 E. W. M. and south of the wagon bridge which is north of the Post office at Tusum Wn. 3rd. The purpose for which said water is intended to be used is power and domestic. The place of intended use is Underwood Wn. 4th it is intended to divert said water by means of flume and pipe line. The general course of the proposed canal is S westerly. The length of the proposed canal is about 7 miles long. 5th it is intended to have the works for diversion and use of said water as aforesaid completed within five years.
