

Notice of Water Right

State of Wisconsin

County of Milwaukee, ss. To all concerned:

Notice is hereby given that Henry W. Schulze of Milwaukee Wisconsin hereby claim the use of the water of the stream running through his claim hereinafter described to the extent of five hundred cubic feet per second. 2nd. It is intended to divert said water at or near the point where a copy of this notice is posted and more particularly described as follows: In St. Helens Mining District beginning on Gold Creek a small stream in the center of section 3 in Tp. 9 North of Range 6 East of W.M. known and named as Henry W. Schulze claim No 1 being about 3/4 miles south of the SWB mining Company claim, Skamania County State of Washington. 3rd The purpose for which said water is intended to be used is power for mining, milling, lighting etc. The place of intended use is on said claim known and named as Henry W. Schulze No. 1. 4th It is intended to divert said water by means of Canal or conduit. The general course of the proposed canal is South along present flow. The length of the proposed canal is about 600 feet. 5th It is intended to have the works for diversion and use of said water as aforesaid completed within ----- years (this must in no case exceed five years)
