

Sheriff of Okanama Co. to E. E. Kanable

I, George Rabenau, Sheriff of the County of Okanama in the State of Washington, do hereby certify that pursuant to a judgment of foreclosure and order of sale entered in the Superior Court of said County and State on the 3rd day of May A.D. 1899 in an action wherein David W. Hutchinson was plaintiff and The Inaid Mining Company, a Corporation, was defendant, said order of sale having been duly certified and together with a writ of execution issued therewith to me as such Sheriff directed and delivered, commanding me to sell according to law all or so much as may be necessary of the real property described in said order to satisfy said judgment amounting to the sum of One Hundred and Ten Dollars, inclusive of interest, costs of suit and increased costs, I gave due and legal notice of said sale and on the 2 day of September A.D. 1899 at 10 o'clock A.M., at the front door of the Court House in Stevenson in said County of Okanama, I duly sold said real property at public auction to the highest bidder, to-wit: to E. E. Kanable who made the highest and best bid therefor at said sale, for the sum of Five and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars per acre and being in the aggregate the sum of One Hundred and Ten Dollars for the 2 acres of said real property situated in said County and State and described in said order as follows:

The Holomon Mining Claim situate in the Blue Bird Gulch, in the Bald Mountain Mining District, in Okanama County, State of Washington, in Township 3 North Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, located by E. Engelsen, and location notice filed in the Auditor's office of Okanama County, Washington, on the 3d day of October, 1895. And I do further certify that the said real property was sold in acre lots or parcels and that the said sum above stated was the highest bid made, and that said sum was the whole price paid for said real property, and that the said property is subject to redemption in one year as provided by law.
