

A. F. HOUSTON to STEVENSON WATER COMPANY

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable consideration this day paid, A. F. Houston does hereby grant to Stevenson Water Co., by P. S. C. Wills, their successors and assigns, a right-of-way along and within two feet of the North line of Lot No. 14, Block Four Upper Cascades Add'n to the Town of Stevenson, Wash. to be used for laying and maintaining a water pipe line for a period of Fifty years from date of this instrument, said pipe line to be laid with good iron pipe and maintained at from 12 to 18 inches below surface of land, without damage to said land.

The Water Company agrees to put in, when pipe line is laid, and to keep in working condition, a T at the Northwest corner of said Lot 14 and to serve water at most favored customer's rate, within 10 days' notice, whenever called upon to do so by said A. F. Houston his successors or assigns.
