Each Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North East quarter (N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East quarter (S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty Three (23) in Township Two (2) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian and containing One Hundred & sixty acres more or less.

Except such taxes as may at this time be due or shall become due.

Together with, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all their estate, right, title and interest in and to the same including dower and claim of dower.
