

DISCHARGE FROM DRAFT  
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That Ralph W. Anderson 3144130 is hereby DISCHARGED from the military service of the UNITED STATES by reason of S. O. 118 para Camp Lewis C.S. Flat Feet Loss Transverse Arch. Fit for domestic service only.

Said Ralph W. Anderson was inducted into the service from the jurisdiction of the Local Board for Skamania Co., State of Wash. on the 21 day of July, 1918.

While this certificate discharges the person named herein from his present obligation to service in the Army, it does not operate as a permanent bar to his subsequent entrance into military service. Under Section 5 of the Act of May 18, 1917, all registered persons remain subject to the draft unless exempted or excused as in that Act provided. Therefore, this discharge does not excuse the holder from obedience to the process of Exemption Boards.
