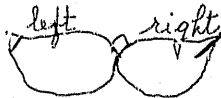


C. D. OTTINGER to THE PUBLIC

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That I, C. D. Ottinger residing at Stevenson in the County of Skamania State of Washington, desiring to adopt a MARK for the purpose of branding or marking live stock in said County, do hereby adopt and claim the sole and exclusive right to use in said County the MARK hereinafter described, for horses, cattle and other live stock; the following being a facsimile and description of said MARK, to-wit:

For all stock: Crop off Left Ear, Slit in Right Ear

And I hereby apply to have the same recorded, and deliver herewith my MARK upon a piece of leather or wood, the same to be retained in the office of the County Auditor of said County.
