

Water Right Notice

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, desiring to avail themselves of the rights and privileges provided by law for the appropriation of water do hereby appropriate from a certain creek the name of which is unknown which creek in southeasterly direction flows through the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14 Township 3 North of range 9 East of the willamette Meridian and enters the Little White Salmon River at or near the center stake on the south line of said section 14 in Skamania county Washington, the water of said creek is hereby appropriated to the extent of five (5) cubic feet per second of time, which claim the undersigned make for themselves their heirs, executors administrators and assigns.

The water hereby appropriated to be taken out at or near the point where this notice is posted to-wit: at or near the point one hundred and seventy (170) feet west and ten (10) feet south of the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of said Section fourteen (14). The water to be taken from said place of diversion by means of a pump or pumps, dam, pipes or flumes, ditches or by any or all of said means as may be convenient or necessary. The water so conducted and converted to be used for manufacturing, power, water supply, domestic and irrigating purposes in the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14 aforesaid and in the Northwest quarter of the adjoining section 23 and in such other places in said sections as may be desired.
