

Eugene L. Meanderville & wife, to Skamania Logging Comp^y

Know all men by these Presents, That we, Eugene L. Meanderville, and ^{Delia M. Meanderville} his wife; of Santa Paula, of the County of Ventura, in the State of California for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred and Seventeen Dollars, to us in hand paid by the Skamania Logging Company, a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of Oregon, of the City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, we have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Skamania Logging Company, a corporation and to its successors and assigns forever, all of that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Lots three (3) and four (4) and the east half of the Southwest quarter of Section seven (7), in township two (2) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing one hundred and sixty-eight and $\frac{40}{100}$ (168.40) acres, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in, or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof.

To have and to hold, the same unto the said Skamania Logging Company, a corporation, and to its successors and assigns forever, and we do hereby covenant with the said grantee, its successors and assigns, that at the date hereof we were well seized in fee simple of the premises above conveyed, and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons whomsoever.
