

due and payable, or to perform any agreement herein contained, shall give to the party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, the option to declare the whole amount due on said note or unpaid thereon, or on this mortgage, at once due and payable, and this mortgage, by reason thereof may be foreclosed at any time thereafter. And that if the said parties of the first part shall fail to pay taxes, assessments, insurance, mechanics' liens or other encumbrances or liens, as herein provided to be done, the party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, shall have the option to pay the same, and the payment so made shall be added to and become part of the amount secured by this mortgage, and draw interest at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, payable at the time of other interest payments herein, without waiver, however, of any rights arising from breach of any of the covenants herein.

It is further expressly agreed:

1st That in case of filing a complaint to foreclose this mortgage, the Court may, on motion of the party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, appoint a receiver to collect rents and profits arising out of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure, and such rents and the profits shall be applied in payment Pro Tanto of the amount due under this mortgage.

2nd In the event of the institution of a suit to foreclose this mortgage the said parties of the first part shall pay such sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees in said suit, and the same shall be a lien upon said described premises; which said fee shall be due when suit is begun and shall be recovered whether final decree is entered or not, and as a part of the costs of the commencement of said suit.
