TO ALL WHO SHALL SEE THESE PRESENTS GREETING:

KNOW YE, THAT REPOSING SPECIAL TRUST AND CONFIDENCE IN THE PATRIOTISM, VALOR, FIDELITY, AND ABILITIES OF ROSCOE MONROE WRIGHT, I DO APPOINT HIM A FIRST LIEUTENANT OF INFANTRY IN THE NATIONAL ARMY, IN THE SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES: TO RANK AS SUCH FROM THE TWENTY-SEVENTH DAY OF NOVEMBER, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN. HE IS THEREFORE CAREFULLY AND DILIGENTLY TO DISCHARGE THE DUTY OF THE OFFICE TO WHICH HE IS APPOINTED BY DOING AND PERFORMING ALL MANNER OF THINGS THEREUNTO BELONGING.

AND I DO STRICTLY CHARGE AND REQUIRE ALL OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS UNDER HIS COMMAND TO BE OBEDIENT TO HIS ORDERS AS AN OFFICER OF HIS GRADE AND POSITION. AND HE IS TO OBSERVE AND FOLLOW SUCH ORDERS AND DIRECTIONS, FROM TIME TO TIME, AS HE SHALL RECEIVE FROM ME, OR THE FUTURE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, OR THE GENERAL OR OTHER SUPERIOR OFFICERS SET OVER HIM, ACCORDING TO THE RULES AND DISCIPLINE OF WAR.

THIS COMMISSION TO CONTINUE IN FORCE DURING THE PLEASURE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, FOR THE TIME BEING, AND FOR THE PERIOD OF THE EXISTING EMERGENCY, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF AN ACT OF CONGRESS APPROVED MAY EIGHTEEN, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN.

GIVEN UNDER MY HAND AT THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, THIS EIGHTH DAY OF NOVEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN, AND IN THE ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-SECOND YEAR OF THE INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES.
