NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THIS 20TH DAY OF APRIL 1920 THAT THE SIFTON LUMBER CO., A CO-PARTNERSHIP COMPOSED OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, J. C. PRICE, G. W. INEBNIT, AND C. F. GEGNER, CLAIMS THE WATER LYING BEING OR FLOWING IN CARSON CREEK IN THE N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 19 T. 3 N. R. 8 E. WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, SKAMANIA COUNTY WASHINGTON TO THE EXTENT OF 60 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND OF TIME.

SAID WATER TO BE DIVERTED IN THE N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 19 T. 3 N. R. 8 E. W.M. BY MEANS OF A DITCH AND WOODEN FLUME AND USED FOR MANUFACTURING PURPOSES, THE PLANS BEING AS FOLLOWS: THE WATER IS TO BE TAKEN OUT OF THE STREAM IN A DITCH AND CONVEYED ABOUT 300 FEET MORE OR LESS, TO A MILL POND, FROM WHICH POND THE WATER WILL BE TAKEN OUT IN A FLUME FOR FLOATING LUMBER TO THE TOWNSITE OF CARSON, AT WHICH PLACE THE WATER WILL BE RETURNED TO THE STREAM.

## WATER APPROPRIATION

357  
BE IT KNOWN: THAT THE UNDERSIGNED CLAIMS THE WATER RUNNING IN THE TUTTLE RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES TO THE EXTENT OF 10,000 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND. BEGINNING IN SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 9 NORTH, RANGE 5 EAST AND CARRIED BY FLUME, CONDUIT OR PIPE TO SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 9 N. RANGE 5 EAST AS CAN BE DETERMINED BY SURVEY FROM THE POWER HOUSE LOCATION.

THIS APPROPRIATION IS MADE FOR THE PURPOSE OF UTILIZING SAID WATER FOR POWER PURPOSES, DOMESTIC USES, MILLING, MINING, MANUFACTURING PURPOSES, GENERATING ELECTRICITY, LIGHTING, SUPPLYING TOWNS AND CITIES WITH WATER, LIGHTS AND POWER.

THE LOCATOR ALSO CLAIMS THE DITCHES AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SAID WATER BY IT CONVEYED FROM SAID POINT OF DIVERSION AND APPROPRIATION, ALSO THE RIGHT OF LOCATION ON ANY AND ALL LANDS, CAMNS, C. RIGHTS AND FLUMES TO BE CONSTRUCTED BY THE LOCATOR OR ASSIGNS, AND TO MAKE USE OF ANY AND ALL PREMISES OR CONSTRUCTIONS PRETAINING THERETO.

THAT THE LOCATOR CLAIMS THE RIGHT TO DISPOSE OF SAID WATER APPROPRIATION AT ANY TIME, AND THAT THE RIGHT TO DISPOSE OF SAID WATER RIGHTS OF SAID WATER APPROPRIATION AT ANY TIME, IN PART OR IN WHOLE, CLAIMING THE SAME ALL AND SINGULAR, UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON.
