Know all Men by these Presents, That I, A. S. Blowers for and in consideration of the partial payment hereinafter specified, do hereby certify and declare that a certain Mortgage, bearing date the Fifth day of December 1900, made and executed by John M. Coulter & Florence F. Coulter Mortgagors to A. S.
