The condition of this obligation is such that whereas the above bounden obligor, Bert Gee, has constructed a school house building for said school district No. 23 under contract entered into between said parties on the 1st day of Sept. 1909 and whereas sufficient time has not elapsed since the construction of the foundation of said building to determine if said foundation is properly constructed and whereas full payment has been made for the construction of said building according to the contract entered into as aforesaid, Now therefore if the said obligor, Bert Gee shall repair any break in said foundation caused by defective workmanship or material that may be found therein on or

before the 1st day of July 1910 and rebuild said foundation on or before July 1st 1910 if same crumbles or is manifestly unsafe and not sufficient support for said building without exp ense to said schall district, then this obligation to be null and void, otherwise to continue in full force and virtue.

Notice of Water Appropriation.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, citizen of the United States, has this day appropriated from the waters of the north or main fork of the Lewis River two thousand cubic feet of water per second of time, said water to be diverted from said stream at an elevation of four thousand feet and to be carried along the right shore a distance of twenty miles by flume and pipes to the place of use. The purposes for which said water is appropriated are for mining, milling, irrigation, domestic, industrial and for the generation of electricity for furnishing towns and cities with electric power light and heat and for all public service uses. A copy of this notice is posted on a large fir tree on the left shore of said stream about 100 feet above where the Bird mountain and niggerhead trail crosses said Lewis River in the Columbia National Forest Reserve in an unsurveyed portion of Skamania County State of Washington.
