KNOW YE THAT HENRY G. HAUSSMAN A PRIVATE OF THE U.S. MARINE CORPS, WHO WAS ENLISTED THE 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1918, AT R.S.D.H., PORTLAND, ORE. TO SERVE FOR THE DURATION OF THE WAR, IS HEREBY HONORABLY DISCHARGED BY SPECIAL ORDER OF THE MAJOR GENERAL COMMANDANT. LETTER NO. 149052-126 D, DATED MARCH 3RD, 1919.

SAID HENRY G. HAUSSMAN WAS BORN AUGUST 20TH, 1898 AT GRESHAM, OREGON, AND WHEN ENLISTED WAS 67 INCHES HIGH, WITH BLUE EYES, DARK BROWN HAIR, RUDDY COMPLEXION; OCCUPATION, LOGGER; CITIZENSHIP, U.S.

APPLIED FOR ENLISTMENT AT PORTLAND, OREGON.

GIVEN UNDER MY HAND AND DELIVERED AT MARINE BARRACKS NAVY YARD PUGET SOUND, WASHINGTON. THIS 5TH DAY OF APRIL, 1919.
