Notice of appropriation of Water

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned W. M. The purpose for which said water is appropriated is for household, domestic and irrigation purposes and the place of intended use is the farm or ranch which premises are particularly described as follows:

The means by which it is intended to divert said water from said stream is at a head gate and dam on Berry Creek 150 feet above the log bridge on the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10 in township 3 north of Range 9 East of Willamette Meridian, from which said head gate by means of a ditch of sufficient size and carrying capacity to carry said water to said premises above mentioned and described.
